As representatives of the people, we need to hear their voices and act accordingly to address their concerns to the best of our ability to promote the general welfare of all New Jerseyans.


We are imploring you to conduct oversight hearings immediately with open public testimony on the following subjects:

- Experiences from people who have been tested for Covid-19, long-term care operators who have been unable to receive vaccine schedules, and from those who have received vaccines or have been trying to schedule an appointment;
- Experiences of those who reside in Veterans' Memorial Homes, have family in the homes and those who work in the homes;
- Experiences from people who have had to go to Motor Vehicle Commission locations and those who work there; and
- Experiences from small-business owners, particularly the restaurant and hospitality industries.
